Newsome Senior High School is a comprehensive public school located in Lithia, Florida. Opened in 2003, the school enrolls 2594 students in grades 9-12. #### **GPA Calculation**

The grade point average is cumulative and includes the high school courses taken in grades 9-12. All courses taken are included in the compilation of the GPA. Grades are computed on a 4.0 system with .04 added to the student's cumulative GPA for each semester Honors course (indicated with a "Y" or an "H" in the course flag column on the transcript) and .08 for each Semester Advance Placement course (indicated with a "Z" in the course flag column on the transcript).
